

The Christmas Valley Back Country Byway, designated on June 29, 1989, is a 93-mile u-shaped route through the high desert landscape of southcentral Oregon. Travel through time with geologic features that take you back to an entirely different environment from thousands of years ago. Today you'll find evidence of volcanic activity in bizarre features such as the Devil's Garden, surrounded by a smooth pahoehoe lava flow, or the vast Crack-in-the-Ground, nearly 2 miles long and 40 feet deep.



The Christmas Valley Back Country Byway GeoTour will guide you to areas with unique and sometimes unexpected natural features. For example, with its breathtaking views, the Black Hills Area of Environmental Concern also hosts three BLM Special Status Species of plants: Cusick's Buckwheat, Warner Mountain Bedstraw, and Snowline Cymopterus.
