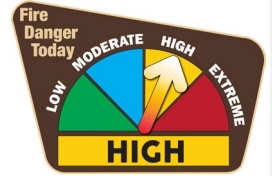


CURRENT RESTRICTIONS

On ALL U.S. Forest Service & BLM-managed public lands within Harney County
EFFECTIVE: FRIDAY, SEPTEMBER 16, 2022



FIRES

PROHIBITED: CAMPFIRES, CHARCOAL BRIQUEUETTES AND PORTABLE BRAZIERES EXCEPT WHEN FULLY CONTAINED WITHIN THE PROVIDED METAL RINGS AT THESE DESIGNATED SITES: Fish Lake Campground (CG), Jackman Park, Chickahominy CG, Page Springs CG, South Steens CG, Buck Springs CG, Delintment CG, Emigrant CG, Falls CG, Idlewild CG, Joaquin Miller CG, Rock Springs CG, Tip Top CG, Yellowjacket CG

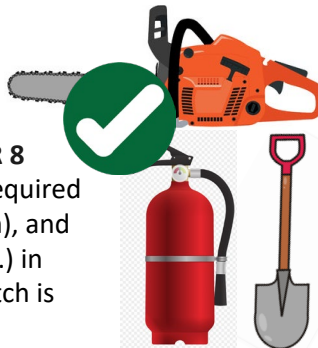
PERMITTED: Liquified and bottled gas stoves, smokers and heaters. When used outside of developed recreation sites, they must be with in an area at least ten (10) feet in diameter that is barren, or clear of all flammable materials.



CHAINSAWS

PERMITTED: Chainsaw operation is permitted **BEFORE 1 p.m.** and **AFTER 8 p.m.** local time. Saw operators are required to have a shovel (8" wide, 26" length), and fire extinguisher (minimum ABC 8 oz.) in their possession. A one-hour fire watch is required after saw operations cease.

For commercial woodworkers, Industrial Fire Precaution Level (IFPL) is 2.



VEHICLES

PROHIBITED: Cross Country Travel. Operating or parking your motorized vehicle or operating any type of Internal combustion engine in an area that is not clear of flammable material. All motorcycles, All-Terrain Vehicles (ATV), and side-by-side Utility Terrain Vehicles (UTV) must be equipped with a functional U.S. Forest Service approved spark arrestor.



EXPLOSIVES

PROHIBITED: Using an explosive. This includes but is not limited to fuses, blasting caps, fireworks, rockets, exploding targets, tracers, and incendiary ammunition.



SMOKING

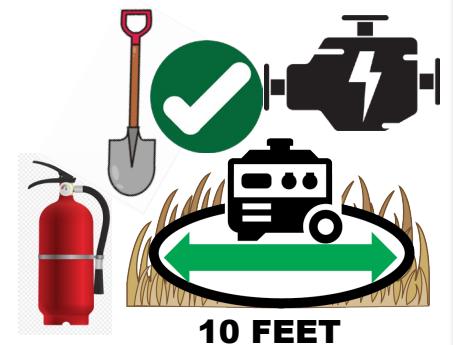
PROHIBITED: Smoking outside except within an enclosed vehicle or building, or in a boat on a river or lake.



ENGINES

PROHIBITED: operating any motorized vehicle or equipment that is wider than 50 inches or has a dry weight of 800 pounds or more, on public lands without a shovel not less than 26 inches in overall length, with a blade not less than 8 inches wide, and a container with at least one gallon of water, or a fully charged 2.5-pound fire extinguisher .

PERMITTED: Generators are allowed when located in a location cleared of flammable material in a 10' diameter and approved spark arrestor.
