1.	Page 2-2		<p>A space is needed between the bold title at the end of page and the line above it.</p> <p>BLM Response: This typo will be fixed in the final Work Plan.</p>
2.	Page 2-4		<p>Are we still referring to them as COPCs rather than COCs? “Mercury, antimony, and arsenic are the primary COPCs. “ On page 2-5 they are called COCs. There is some inconsistency within the document.</p> <p>BLM Response: Both “contaminants of potential concern (COPCs)” and “contaminants of concern (COCs)” are intentionally used in the subject Work Plan in an attempt to be consistent with how these terms were used in the documents or activities that are described in the subject Work Plan. For example, in describing the RI (see Work Plan Section 2.1), the original objectives and RI are presented as they were presented in the RI Work Plan and RI report (e.g., to “characterize the nature and extent of COPCs...”). Where the subject Work Plan refers to the final selected COCs, the term COCs is used. The document will be carefully reviewed and revised as appropriate to assure that the use of these terms is as intended.</p>
