Box 7 – By what instrument did you receive title?

Box 8 – What date did you learn that you may not have clear title. Enter at least month and year.

Box 16.a – DO NOT INCLUDE MONEY WITH APPLICATION FORM.

Box 16.b – Complete Form 2540-2 showing all conveyances affecting title to lands.

Box 16.c – FORM 2540-3 IS NOT REQUIRED, DO NOT INCLUDE WITH APPLICATION FORM.

Make sure to include a signature and date signed for <u>each</u> claimant as shown on the title (deed , probate or succession document.)
