Recreation Site Maintenance



Pine Creek Special Recreation Management Area

In 2022 Recreation Fee Account funds were spent on supplies and labor to maintain and operate six developed recreation sites within the Kemmerer Field Office. Restrooms and dumpster trailers received servicing throughout the season. The drinking water system at Fontenelle Creek Campground was tested monthly May through September and winterized at the end of the season. Weeds were trimmed and numerous other maintenance tasks were performed to ensure visitor satisfaction and safety.

Amount Expended: \$9,000.00

Slate Creek CG Visitor Survey

In the summer of 2022 visitor satisfaction surveys were conducted at Slate Creek Campground and boat launch. Located along the Green River prized for fishing and floating this campground is popular for locals and visitors from out of state. Surveys collected visitors' demographic information and levels of satisfaction with the facilities and services the BLM provides. This data will be valuable in future planning and decision making for the area.

Amount Expended: \$2,000.00

Recreation Fee Dollars

They support and enhance:

Recreation fee dollars are an investment in outdoor recreation. Current and future generations benefit as 100% of the funds collected are reinvested in the facilities and services that visitors enjoy, use, and value.

- Maintenance, repair, and facility enhancement related directly to visitor enjoyment, visitor access, and health and safety
- Interpretation, visitor information, visitor service, visitor needs assessments, and signs
- Habitat restoration directly related to wildlife- dependent recreation that is limited to hunting, fishing, wildlife observation, or photography
- Law enforcement related to public use and recreation
- Direct operating or capital costs associated with the recreation fee program



Other Accomplishments

Recreation fee account funding was spent on the administration and monitoring of new and existing Special Recreation Permits.
