



## PUBLIC USE FIRE RESTRICTIONS ORDER LIFTED SPOKANE DISTRICT BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT

Public Use Fire Restrictions, including shooting restrictions, are hereby lifted on lands administered by the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) and the Bureau of Reclamation (BOR) in eastern Washington. This will take effect on 12:01 a.m. Thursday, September 7, 2023, in the following eastern Washington counties: Adams, Asotin, Benton, Chelan, Columbia, Douglas, Ferry, Franklin, Garfield, Grant, Kittitas, Klickitat, Lincoln, Okanogan, Pend Oreille, Spokane, Stevens, Walla Walla, Whitman, and Yakima.

Ignition of fireworks is prohibited on all federal public lands, (43 CFR 9212.1(h)) and (43 CFR 423.30(c)). In addition, the use of exploding targets and incendiary bullets are also prohibited. Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of be fined not more than \$100,000 and/or imprisoned for not more than 12 months, or both.

This order will be effective 12:01 a.m. September 7, 2023.
