



Description: The Wild Rivers Backcountry Byway provides the only vehicle access to the Wild Rivers Recreation Area within Rio Grande del Norte National Monument, which leads to the stunning scenery of the Rio Grande Gorge. This project performs a second phase of work, repairing outstanding maintenance issues, repaving the byway within the monument, and establishing a dedicated bike lane to improve safety for cyclists.
