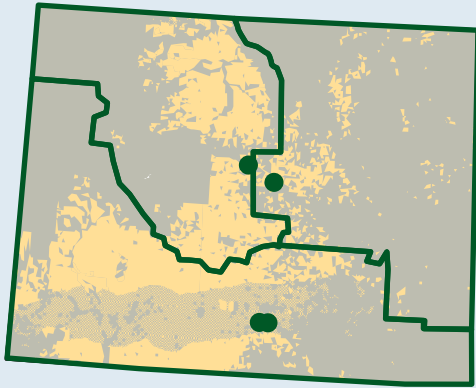

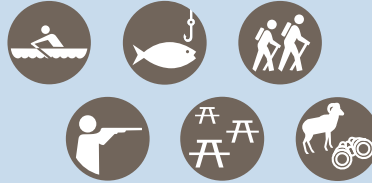

Maintenance of these dams and their associated reservoirs reduces safety risks and provides continued resource benefits and recreation opportunities for the public.

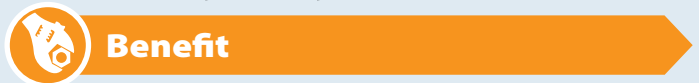
GAOA Funding, Fiscal Year 2023:
