RESCISSION OF EMERGENCY CLOSURE ORDER

AGENCY: Bureau of Land Management (BLM), Roseburg District, Oregon.

ACTION: Rescission of temporary closure of public lands managed by the BLM, Swiftwater Field Office, near the Chilcoot Fire.

SUMMARY: This notice rescinds the emergency closure of BLM-administered public lands in the Swiftwater Field Office, Douglas County, issued on August 31, 2023, associated with the Chilcoot fire, as described below:

All BLM public lands within T.24 S., R.01 W. sections 1, 2, 11, 12, 13, 14, 23, 24, 25, 26, and 35. As well as T.25 S., R.01 W. sections 1, 11, 14, 23, 24, and 25. This includes the closure of Scaredman Recreation Site.

As Swiftwater Field Manager I have determined that fire and resource conditions have changed, and the closure is no longer needed.

The public is reminded that all laws protecting public lands and resources from damage or unauthorized use remain in place; violators can be prosecuted, and convictions can lead to fines or imprisonment.

This rescission does not change the status of any other BLM closure or fire restriction orders.

AFFECTED AREA: The BLM-administered lands in the Swiftwater Field Office along Canton Creek and Pass Creek. These lands are in Douglas County, Oregon.

EFFECTIVE DATE: This change will take effect at 1:00 p.m. on Wednesday, September 27, 2023.
