
Famous Pioneers Logic Puzzle

Clues:

- 1. The three emigrant parties are the Whitmans, the ones who traveled in 1856 and the ones headed for free farmland.
- 2. The Martin Company did not suffer from Native American Conflict.
- 3. The Donner Party traveled before the Martin Company, but after the Whitman Party.
- 4. The Martin Company was seeking freedom from religious persecution.
- 5. The Whitmans were not headed to California.
- 6. The party seeking to get free farmland was not headed to Utah or Oregon.
- 7. The company seeking to start a mission traveled first.
- 8. The party seeking to start a mission was not plagued by snow on their journey.
- 9. The group that traveled last got stuck in Wyoming, not far from Casper.
- 10. The first party to travel was headed to Oregon Country.
