## **Datil Well Campground New Group Site Facilities**

The Datil Well Campground is a popular recreation site within the Socorro Field Office. Over time, the area has seen increased visitation and use. The one existing group shelter at the site does not provide enough infrastructure for the current visitation. The Bureau of Land Management will develop a new group site and associated facilities to accommodate and support current and future recreational use. This additional group site will provide visitors with ample space and modern amenities to safely enjoy public lands. This project will include the installation of a new vault toilet, a new group shelter, new picnic tables and a new parking area.
