



FIRE RESTRICTIONS ORDER LIFTED SPOKANE DISTRICT BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT

Fire restrictions are hereby lifted on lands administered by the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) and the Bureau of Reclamation (BOR) in Washington. This will take effect on 12:01 a.m. Tuesday, September 17, 2024, in the following Washington counties: Adams, Asotin, Benton, Chelan, Clallam, Clark, Columbia, Cowlitz, Douglas, Ferry, Franklin, Garfield, Grant, Grays Harbor, Island, Jefferson, King, Kitsap, Kittitas, Klickitat, Lewis, Lincoln, Mason, Okanogan, Pacific, Pend Oreille, Pierce, San Juan, Skagit, Skamania, Snohomish, Spokane, Stevens, Thurston, Wahkiakum, Walla Walla, Whatcom, Whitman, and Yakima Counties.

On all federal public lands, ignition of fireworks is prohibited (43 CFR 9212.1(h)) and (43 CFR 423.30(c)). In addition, the use of exploding targets and incendiary bullets remain prohibited. Violation of these prohibitions is punishable by a fine of not more than \$1,000 or imprisonment of not more than 12 months, or both.

This order will take effective at 12:01 a.m. September 17, 2024, and will remain in effect unless otherwise published.
