Termination of Fire Prevention Orders Fire Restrictions Rescinded

High Plains District Office

Pursuant to Title 43 CFR 9212, the prohibitions listed in the follow Fire Prevention Orders: BLM-WY-060-2024-1,2; BLM-WY-070-2024-1,2; and BLM-WY-080-2024-1,2; are hereby terminated effective November 25th, 2024.

This is applicable to the following Field Offices within the High Plains District: Casper, Buffalo, and Newcastle.

The following year-round fire prevention restrictions are still in effect on BLM-administered lands in Wyoming:

- Discharge or use of any fireworks.
- Discharge of a firearm using incendiary or tracer ammunition.
- Burn, ignite or cause to burn any tire, wire, magnesium, or any other hazardous or explosive material.
- Operate any off-road vehicle on public lands unless the vehicle is equipped with a properly installed spark arrester pursuant to 43 CFR 8343.1 (c).
- Use/discharge of explosives of any kind, incendiary devices, pyrotechnic devices, or exploding targets.
