

- Non-motorized and mechanized use only.
- Open to class 1, 2 and 3 E-bikes and nonmotorized travel.
- Use is limited to OHVs weighing 1,000 pounds or less curb weight and a maximum width of 50 inches.
- Use is limited to OHVs weighing 1500 pounds or less curb weight and a maximum width of 64 inches.

- legal vehicles.
- Non-BLM Trail

- Cross-country travel allowed for OHVs 1,000 pounds or less curb weight and a maximum width of 50 inches.
- No Summer Use of OHVs.
- OHVs limited to designated routes, no crosscountry travel allowed.
- Mountains Units Cross-country travel allowed for OHVs 1,500 pounds or less curb weight and a maximum width of 64 inches.
- Nome Creek Tailings near the bridge and landing - Open to cross-country travel.
 - Nome Creek Tailings Cross-country travel allowed for street legal OHVs 10,000 lbs or
- less or non-street legal OHVs 1,500 lbs curb weight or less. All other OHVs are limited to designated routes.
