**Amount Expended: \$12,477.45**

The Field Office maintains and manages Corn Springs campground and two Long Term Visitor Areas (LVTA) (Midland and Mule Mountains). Mule Mountains LVTA includes two special recreation permit areas, Wiley's Well and Coon Hollow campground. Three campgrounds have onsite volunteer hosts, water systems, vault toilets, and dump stations. Funding was used to clean and maintain these areas weekly and complete a much needed repair on the Wiley Well campground toilet.

The Field Office issues and manages several special recreation permits (SRPs). These SRPs encompass a variety of recreational activities, ranging from competitive motocross events and guided off-roading tours to art fairs and bus tours.
