Public Use Restriction: Low Fire Danger

Pursuant to 43 CFR (Code of Federal Regulations) 9212.1(h), the following acts are prohibited on lands administered by the Bureau of Land Management Medford District beginning at 12:01am, June 1st, 2025.

- 1. Smoking is prohibited while traveling, except in vehicles on improved roads, in boats on the water, and other designated locations.
- 2. Power saw use is permitted all day during low fire danger. Each power saw is required to have one shovel and one fire extinguisher of at least eight ounce capacity. A Firewatch of at least one hour is required following the use of each saw.
- 3. Possession of the following firefighting equipment is required while traveling, except on state highways, county roads and driveways: one shovel and one gallon of water or one 2¹/₂ pound or larger fire extinguisher. All-terrain vehicles and motorcycles must be equipped with one 2¹/₂ pound or larger fire extinguisher.
- 4. This order prohibits igniting, possession, or use of fireworks, exploding targets, metal targets, and firing tracer or incendiary devices.

Anyone who is found guilty of violating a fire prevention order may be subject to prosecution under any applicable law or BLM regulation. A violation of this order may be classified as a Class A Misdemeanor Offense under 43 USC 1733(a) FLPMA, 18 USC 3559, and 18 USC 3571 Sentence of Fine - Sentencing Reform Act, Oct. 12, 1984. If the violation does not result in death, anyone who violates this order may be fined not more than \$100,000 and/or imprisoned for not more than 12 months, or may be fined in accordance with the applicable provisions of 18 USC 3571. Restitution for total fire suppression and damage costs incurred will be borne by the responsible party.
