RECISSION OF EMERGENCY PUBLIC LAND CLOSURE

AGENCY: Bureau of Land Management, Prineville District

ACTION: Removal of Temporary Closure of Public Lands

SUMMARY: This notice rescinds the emergency closure of BLM-administered lands in the Prineville District, Deschutes Field Office issued on June 17, 2025, on or near the Alder Springs wildfire. Pursuant to 43 CFR 8364, the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) hereby provides notice that effective at 6:00 AM on June 21, 2025, the public lands described below are OPEN to public access. The BLM is opening these public lands as the emergency crews have completed active fire suppression in this area.

AFFECTED AREA: The following BLM-managed lands in Jefferson County, Oregon County are open to public use, including the Steelhead Falls, Scout Camp and Otter Bench Trailheads and trail systems:

All BLM-administered lands in the boundary from the southern end of Lake Billy Chinook east to Highway 97, heading south along Hwy 97 to the Jefferson County line, west to the western boundary of the Crooked River National Grassland and following the Crooked River National Grassland western boundary north up to Lake Billy Chinook.
