

# FIRE RESTRICTIONS

IN EFFECT: Friday, June 13, 2025.

On BLM-administered public lands within the Burns District, Oregon, from Highway 78 and Folly Farm Road, southwest along the crest of the Steens Mountain and the crest of the Pueblo Mountains to the Oregon/Nevada border and then following the Burns District boundary east and north until it reaches the Folly Farm Road at highway 78. In addition, Ignition, possession, or use of fireworks, exploding targets, and/or metal targets, and firing tracer or incendiary devices are prohibited on ALL BLM-administered public lands within BLM Burns District, Oregon



**PROHIBITED:** Building, maintaining, attending or using a fire, campfire,

using liquified or bottled fuel.





**PROHIBITED:** Operating a chainsaw or other equipment powered by an internal combustion engine.

### **SMOKING**

**PROHIBITED:** Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or building or in a boat on a river or lake.





#### EXPLOSIVES

**PROHIBITED:** Using an explosive. This includes but is not limited to fuses, blasting caps, fireworks, rockets, exploding targets, tracers, and incendiary ammunition.



## **VEHICLES**

**PROHIBITED:** Possessing or using a vehicle off National Forest System roads, except when parking in an area devoid of vegetation within 10 feet of the roadway.





**PROHIBITED:** Operating or using any internal or external combustion engine without a spark arresting device properly installed, maintained and in effective working order in accordance with U.S. Forest Service Standards.

**PERMITTED:** Generators are allowed when used in the center of an area at least 10-feet in diameter that is barren or cleared of all flammable material, or when fully contained within a pickup truck bed devoid of all flammable material.
