RECORDABLE DISCLAIMER OF INTEREST

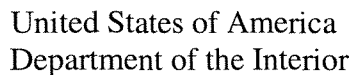

WHEREAS, the State of Alaska is entitled to a recordable disclaimer of interest pursuant to Section 315(a) of the Federal Land Policy and Management Act of October 21, 1976, 43 U.S.C. 1745(a), the United States of America, acting by and through the BLM – Alaska State Director, hereby gives notice that the United States claims no real property interest in and therefore disclaims any and all real property interest in the submerged lands more particularly described as:

The lands underlying the Kasilof River, between the lines of ordinary high water marks on its banks, from its mouth at Cook Inlet, upstream approximately thirteen (13) river miles to the western boundary of the Kenai National Wildlife Refuge at sections 5 and 8, T. 2 N., R. 11 W., presently located in the following areas: T. 4 N., R. 12 W., and Tps. 3 N., Rs. 11 and 12 W., and sections 5 and 8, T. 2 N., R. 11 W., Seward Meridian (SM), Alaska.

This disclaimer is subject to all valid existing rights, if any.

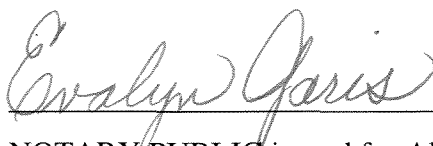
