Rescission of Emergency Closure Order

Vees Fire Area Closure

Due to reduced wildland fire activity and successful suppression efforts on the Vees Fire the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) Worland Field Office rescinded the fire area closure that temporarily closed BLM lands in Washakie County within and adjacent to the area of the Vees Fire as described below. The closure will end at 10:00 p.m. Friday August 1, 2025, leaving no remaining public access closures associated with the Vees Fire.

Previous Closure Area Described

Within the described area all BLM roads, trails, and lands are open to public access.
