### 2.5 Mile Creek Riparian Area Restoration

Come join us improve riparian habitat along the 2.5 Mile Creek north of Pocatello by building simple rock structures known as Zeedyk Structures. Volunteers will repair existing structures as well as install new ones. These rock structures are designed to stop the progress of headcuts upstream and increase access to the floodplain during spring runoff while allowing for continued streamflow.

*Volunteers should be prepared to get wet, a bit muddy, and have a lot of fun, as they work within the stream channel. Bring water and snacks.*

*Gloves will be provided.*
