The meeting was conducted virtually due to BLM travel restrictions limiting non-essential travel. Major topics included management plans for the newly acquired Ólak Ólohtem-Lost Coast Redwoods property featuring coastline and old-growth redwoods with significant tribal cultural importance, and Forest Service fee proposals for recreation sites that had been delayed since 2021. Wild horse management dominated public comment, with speakers advocating for higher population limits and increased fertility control rather than roundups for areas currently exceeding target population ranges.
