RECISSION OF EMERGENCY PUBLIC CLOSURE

AGENCY: Bureau of Land Management, Prineville District, Oregon.

ACTION: Recission of Emergency Closure of Public Lands

SUMMARY: This notice supersedes the emergency closure of BLM-administered public lands in the Prineville District issued on September 7, 2025, in and around the Black Rock Fire.

Pursuant to 43 CFR 8364, the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) hereby provides notice on the following public lands described in the September 7 closure:

As of 8:00 AM on Saturday, **September 13**, all BLM-managed lands on either side of the John Day River north of the North Pole Ridge Wilderness Study Area, including Armstrong Canyon Road and the Thirtymile Recreation Area, will be OPEN TO PUBLIC ACCESS under existing rules.

As of 8:00 AM on Monday, **September 15**, the remaining BLM-managed lands in the original closure, including dispersed camping areas and travel on Clarno Road north of Highway 218, will be OPEN TO PUBLIC ACCESS under existing rules.
