



Downloading forms in Survey123

Before heading into the field, you will need to download the relevant seed collection and scouting forms so that you can view them when you are out of cell service.


1. Sign into Survey123.




2. Your organization is “GeoPlatform”


3. Login to “Login.gov”



4. Open Survey123 and click “Download surveys”. If you have no surveys, your screen will look like the image on the left. If you have other surveys already downloaded, you will need to click on your account icon in the upper right corner of the screen, as shown in the image on the right.



- Next, click the cloud icon on the Seed Collection and Scouting forms for your SOS team to begin the downloads. Once the icon changes from being a cloud to two arrows, click the back button in the upper left.



- You should now see the surveys you will need for SOS seed collecting on your home screen. Please do not input anything into the surveys or submit anything at this time!
