21 Road Adobe and Fill Dirt Community Pit COCO106105857

Adobe clay and fill dirt material is available for purchase from the 21 Road Adobe and Fill Dirt Community Pit. The pit contains dirt and clay surface sediments that are common to the Grand Valley and is considered suitable for brick manufacture or fill material. Depth to the underlying Mancos Shale bedrock is unknown, but it is projected to be 15 to 20 feet below the surface.

Clay dirt material can be purchased from the BLM 21 Road Adobe and Fill Dirt Community Pit for \$0.57 a cubic yard, and a reclamation fee of \$0.27 per cubic yard sold. A contract of sales is obtained from the Bureau of Land Management at the Grand Junction Field Office located at 2815 H Rd, Grand Junction, CO 81506. Excavation and removal activities are limited to the existing site disturbance and are not permitted during wet or muddy conditions. The material is hard and compacted and may be easier to transport if it is broken up with tools prior to loading. The use of heavy equipment must be approved in the contract. Do not remove the topsoil stockpiled along the western sides of the pit because it will be used for future reclamation of the site. The BLM does not guarantee in any way, access onto or out of the pit site.

Directions from Grand Junction: Take US Highway 6 & 50 to 21 Road. Travel north on 21 Road for approximately 6 miles and cross Highline Canal. The pit is located on the east side of the canal inside the larger BLM Colorado North Desert Recreation Management Area and is separated from 21 Road by a cattle guard and barbed wire fence.
