



**Price:** \$2.45/ton, \$1.75/cy + \$25.30 reclamation fee per ton or cy


**Location:** 38.2082, -106.0272

## ACCESS

Access to the site is accessible by most vehicles. Access Saguache County Road HH58 off of Highway 285. Turn at the San Luis Valley Campground and stay on the CR for about 5.5-6 miles.

## GEOLOGY

The community pit is located in one of the exposed pods of Paleozoic rocks including the Leadville Limestone. The rock was originally mined as a locatable limestone to assist with the reclamation efforts in Kerber Creek. The remaining stockpile and reclamation fee will assist in unfinished reclamation at the excavation site.



## RULES

A contract for the sale of mineral materials is required

- Limit use to designated roads and trails.
- Removal of materials from the stockpiles only.
- Use of equipment is allowable, please pressure was prior to entry to avoid the spread of noxious weeds.

- Adhere to state and federal rules, including weight restrictions and speed regulations.
- If purchaser violates provisions of the permit they may lose their future rights to remove materials.
