

The land area code for this nomination is WVES106738235. This nomination is for a Coal Lease by Application (LBA) located in the R.D. Baily Lake Wildlife Management Area in Mingo and Wyoming Counties, West Virginia.

The tracts encompassed in the proposed LBA are United States Army Corps of Engineers (USACE) managed Federal surface tracts, as described from deeds or Declaration of Takings in the District Court for the Southern District, West Virginia.

These tracts are a portion of USACE lands depicted on a series of Project Maps created by the USACE, Huntington District, Ohio River Division, signed by the District Engineer on April 23, 1964, for the R.D. Baily Lake Project. The map segments used for this review were Segment Nos. 7, 8 and 16. Lands nominated for this project include all or a portion of USACE Tract Nos. 714, 734, 736, 737, 775-2, 834, 875-1, 1600, 1601, and 1675. The three USACE Project Maps are provided with this document and are shown as **Exhibit "A"**.

The nomination is described as being one tract of land which includes all or a portion of the aforementioned USACE Tracts. A drawing titled "DESCRIPTION OF LAND PLAT" with a metes and bounds description of the perimeter of the nominated lands shown on the map, was provided by Navigation Environmental & Technical Services, Inc., located in Summersville, West Virginia. This drawing and description is provided with this document and is shown as **Exhibit "B"**.

The aforementioned drawing and a compilation of metes and bounds descriptions of the Federally owned tracts were utilized to create the hereinafter provided legal description and calculate the acreage for this legal land description.

BEGINNING at the top of a ridge marking the point common to Logan, Mingo, and Wyoming Counties in West Virginia, identical with a corner of USACE Tracts Nos. 714 and 1600. There is no indication that this **POINT OF BEGINNING** has been monumented.
