



## Van and Bus Tours



The Red Rock Canyon National Conservation Area is currently allowing small van and bus tours to enter the Scenic Loop Drive for limited activities and stops. Vehicles may tour the Scenic Drive, but are limited to the specific activities and locations listed below.

### Where can van and bus tours go?

Allowed areas are the parking lots at Calico I, Willow Spring, and Pine Creek. Tours may also stop at the Visitor Center. For Visitor Center parking, please park in the lowest lot. No other stops are allowed and groups must stay in the parking lot area.

### What can these tours do?

These tours may drive on the Scenic Loop and stop at the 3 parking areas listed above. Hiking is not allowed and tours must work with an existing permitted company or obtain a Special Recreation Permit from the BLM for additional activities.

### How do we make a reservation and pay?

To enter the Scenic Drive you must make a reservation through Recreation.gov and pay the \$20 entrance fee and \$2 reservation fee. Upon arriving at Red Rock Canyon NCA you will pay an additional \$5 per passenger at the fee gate, excluding the driver.

Reservations are required from October 1 through May 31 each year. No reservation is required during the summer season. Reservations open up a month in advance on Recreation.gov.



### Are there permit requirements for tours on SR 159?

The BLM allows tour companies to use State Route 159 for tours without a permit, but stops at the Red Rock Dedication Overlook and trails off of SR-159 must be permitted. State of Nevada and NDOT rules apply to SR 159.
