### **Fire Prevention Order: UTW002-2026-06 Stage 3 Fire Restrictions – Cherry Fire**

**June 29, 2026**

**Action:** Pursuant to Title 43, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR) Section 9212.2 (a), (b)(1), the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) hereby provides notice that effective immediately, public lands described below are closed to all forms of public access. This order is for public and firefighter safety with suppression efforts for the Cherry Fire (UT-WDD-260218).

**Affected Area:** All BLM managed lands in Juab and Tooele counties west of Highway 6, beginning at Weiss Highway, extending north to Highway 36, then south along Highway 36 near Powell Springs Road, following the United States Forest Service (USFS) boundary near Cow Hollow Road down to Coyote Knoll Road, returning to Weiss Highway and Little Sahara Main Road. While Little Sahara Recreation Area remains accessible, the Cherry Creek area is not open to the public.

**Prohibitions:** The public must not enter the closure area. Entry on roads, trails, or cross-country travel on any land designated in the closure order. Exemptions from this closure are noted below under Supplemental Information.

**Supplemental Information:** The following persons are exempt from the provisions of this Order:

1. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized medical, rescue or firefighting force engaged in fire, emergency, or law enforcement activities, or public utility employees engaged in emergency repairs
2. BLM employees, contractors, or agents engaged in official duties
3. Parties who carry written approval signed by the BLM Authorized Officer, allowing access to the described public lands

**Penalties:** Any person who violates this Closure Order may be subject to civil liability or criminal prosecution under any applicable law or BLM regulation and be fined in accordance with 18 U.S.C. 3571, imprisoned for no more than 12 months, or both. Vehicles found in violation of this order may be removed.

**Effective Dates:** This closure is effective immediately, upon signature, and will remain in effect until such time as conditions allow for safe use of these public lands and until rescinded by the Authorized Officer.
