Notice of Temporary Closure or Restriction Order CA360-26-01

OFFICE: Redding Field Office/California BLM

ACTION: Temporary Closure

SUMMARY:

The Bureau of Land Management will temporarily close the Sacramento River Rail Trail in Shasta County, CA. The trail and a distance of 50 feet on either side of the trail will be temporarily closed.

Location	Start of closure	End of closure
Shasta Trailhead to Keswick Boat Ramp	Monday, June 1 at 6am	Friday, June 5 at 3pm
Keswick Boat Ramp to Keswick Dam Trailhead (including Rock Creek Trail)	Monday, June 8 at 6 am	Friday, June 12 at 3pm

All public use of the trail is prohibited. The trail will remain closed overnight.

The closure is needed for necessary trail maintenance to occur. Heavy equipment will be operating on and near the trail. Debris will cover parts of the trail during operations. This closure will ensure safety of maintenance workers as well as the safety of recreational users.

RATIONALE:

The area will be closed for eight days under 43 CFR 8364.1 in order to protect persons and public lands.

The Rail Trail is undergoing more intensive maintenance over the next year. The first step is to clean and reconstruct trailside ditches. Heavy equipment such as a mini-excavator and road grader will be used on the trail to accomplish this task. Poor sightlines along the trail, and the high speeds of some users on the trail, necessitate closing the trail to protect the safety of both maintenance workers and trail users.

This closure aligns with the Northwest California Integrated Management Plan's Public Health and Safety guidance.

EXEMPTIONS:

This order does not apply to Federal, State, and local officers and employees in the performance of their official duties; members of organized rescue or firefighting forces in the performance of their official duties; and persons with written authorization from the BLM.

LOCATION: Sacramento River Rail Trail. See attached map.

June 1, 2026 at 6am to June 5, 2026 at 3pm

June 8, 2026 at 6am to June 12, 2026 at 3pm

NOTIFICATION METHODS AND POSTED LOCATIONS: This order and map will be posted on the Redding Field Office website, posted at the front desk of the Redding Field Office, posted near the closure area on kiosks or temporary notice boards, shared with local media and shared with our local partners, such as the City of Redding.

ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTIES *Any person who violates the temporary closures or restrictions in this order may be tried before a United States magistrate and fined in accordance with [18 U.S.C. 3571](#), imprisoned no more than 12 months under [43 U.S.C. 1733\(a\)](#) and [43 CFR 8360.0-7](#), or both. In accordance with [43 CFR 8365.1-7](#), State or local officials may also impose penalties for violations of State law.*
