TEMPORARY CLOSURE ORDER

Bureau of Land Management, Idaho

CLOSURE OF Certain Lands within the BLM Saylor Creek Herd Management Area

June 17, 2026

Action: Pursuant to Section 303(a) of the Federal Land Policy and Management Act of 1976 (43 U.S.C. 1733(a)), 43 CFR 9268.3(d), and 43 CFR 8364.1, the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) provides notice that, effective upon execution of this order, certain public lands within the Saylor Creek Herd Management Area (HMA) are closed to the public.

The purpose of this closure is to protect public health and safety while supporting safe and efficient wild horse gather operations to ensure humane care and treatment of all captured animals. Only authorized gather personnel will be allowed at trap sites and authorized public at viewing sites during gather operations.

This action is associated with the removal of excess wild horses as part of the Jarbidge Field Office's Saylor Creek HMA Wild Horse Drive-Trap Gather Operation. Additional information and updates regarding this gather operation are available at BLM.gov.

Affected Area: This temporary closure includes all public lands within 2-miles of any wild horse trap location and public viewing areas within the Saylor Creek HMA while gather operations are conducted as shown on the associated map.


Prohibitions: All forms of public access and entry are prohibited.

Penalties: Any person who violates this Order may be tried before a United States Magistrate and fined a maximum of \$1,000.00 and imprisoned no more than 12 months, in accordance with 43 CFR 8364.1 (E).

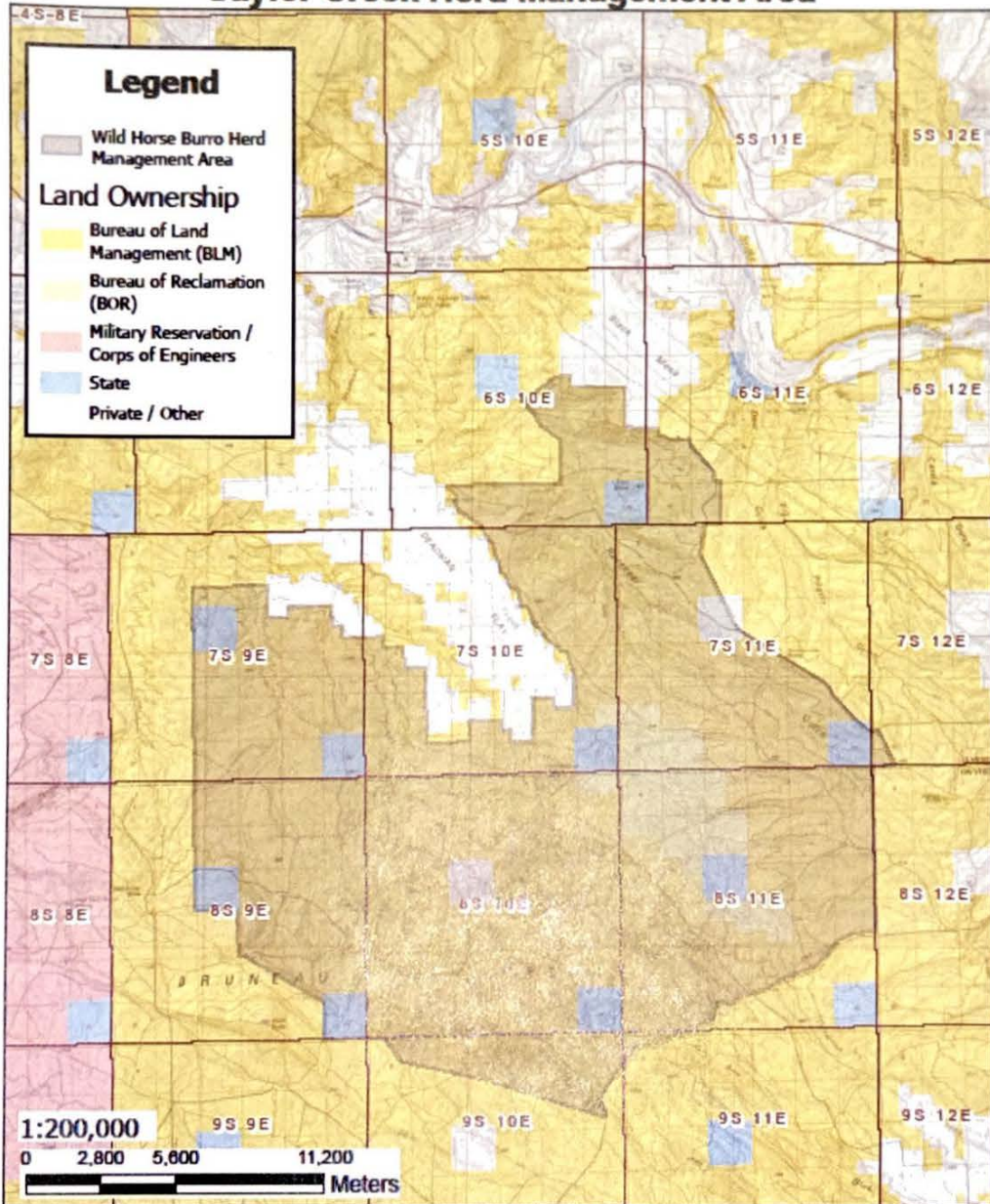
Effective: This Order is effective upon execution of this order and will remain in effect through completion of gather operations within the Saylor Creek HMA.
