RECISSION OF EMERGENCY PUBLIC LAND CLOSURE

AGENCY: Bureau of Land Management, Prineville District

ACTION: Removal of Temporary Closure of Public Lands

SUMMARY: This notice rescinds the emergency closure of BLM-administered lands in the Prineville District, Deschutes Field Office, issued on July 23, 2026, on or near the 10-Mile Fire. Pursuant to 43 CFR 8364, the Bureau of Land Management (BLM) hereby provides notice that effective at 0600 on July 31, 2026, the public lands described below are OPEN to public access. The BLM is opening these public lands as the emergency crews have completed active fire suppression in this area.

AFFECTED AREA: The following BLM-managed lands in Jefferson and Wasco Counties are open to public use, including the Mecca and Trout Creek boat launch and campgrounds.

From the Warm Springs boat launch near the Hwy 26 Bridge across the Deschutes River: North (downstream) on the Deschutes River to the Locked Gate on the Deschutes River Access Road East on a line to Hwy 97 Southerly on Hwy 97 to the intersection with Hwy 26 North on Hwy 26 to the Warm Springs boat launch. **Please note: the Warm Springs boat launch remains closed under the Bench Fire Closure Order.**
