



Termination of Fire Prevention Order COS05-26-02

Uncompahgre Field Office

Pursuant to Title 43 CFR 9212.2(a), the temporary emergency closure order issued June 29, 2026, is hereby terminated, lifting the remaining emergency closure on Bureau of Land Management-administered public lands associated with the Gold Mountain Fire effective immediately. All public lands previously closed under the June 29, 2026 emergency closure order are reopened to public entry and use.

This order is effective immediately.
