FIRE PREVENTION ORDER: OR-SPD-2026-01

Due to public safety concerns and to facilitate suppression efforts for the Sinlahekin Fire (#WA-NES-001791), pursuant to Title 43, Code of Federal Regulations (CFR), Section 9212.2 (a), (b)(1), the following Bureau of Land Management lands administered by the Wenatchee Field Office are closed to public entry. These lands are described as follows:

All BLM-managed lands (except Split Rock Day Use Area) in the area north from where the Pine Creek Road intersects with Highway 97, to the intersection of Fish Lake Road, following Fish Lake Road west to the intersection of Sinlahekin Road, following the Sinlahekin Road south to the intersection of North Fork Salmon Creek Road, turning north and following North Fork Salmon Creek to where it turns Service Road 3800, following Forest Road 3800 to the junction with Forest Road 3820, following Forest Road 3820 north and west to the section line between sections 13 and 14 in T37N R23E, following the section line north to the Canadian border, following the Canadian border east to the border crossing at Chopaka Road, south on Chopaka Road to the intersection with Loomis-Oroville Highway, south and west on the Loomis-Oroville Highway to the junction with Highway 97, south on Highway 97 to the junction with Pine Creek Road. Please see the associated map.

Under 43 CFR 9212.1 Prohibited acts: Unless permitted in writing by the authorized officer, the following acts are prohibited until further notice:

Entry on roads, trails, or cross-country travel upon any lands designated in this closure order. EXEMPTIONS

This order does not apply to Federal, State, and local officers and employees in the performance of their official duties; members of organized rescue or firefighting forces in the performance of their official duties; and persons with written authorization from the BLM.

This order does not apply to activities conducted under contract with the BLM, agency personnel monitoring the event, or activities conducted under an approved plan of operations. Authorized users must have in their possession a written permit or contract from the BLM, signed by the authorized officer.

An exemption does not absolve an individual or organization from liability or responsibility for any fire started by the exempted activity.

PENALTIES

Anyone in violation of this Fire Prevention Order may be subject to civil liability or criminal prosecution under any applicable law or BLM regulation. A violation of this Order may be classified as a Class A Misdemeanor Offense under 43 USC 1733(a) FLPMA, 18 USC 3559. Pursuant to 18 USC 3571, if the violation does not result in death, anyone who violates this order may be fined not more than \$100,000 and/or imprisoned for not more than 12 months. Liability for total fire suppression and damage costs incurred will be borne by the responsible party.

This Order will be effective immediately upon signature and in effect until order is rescinded.

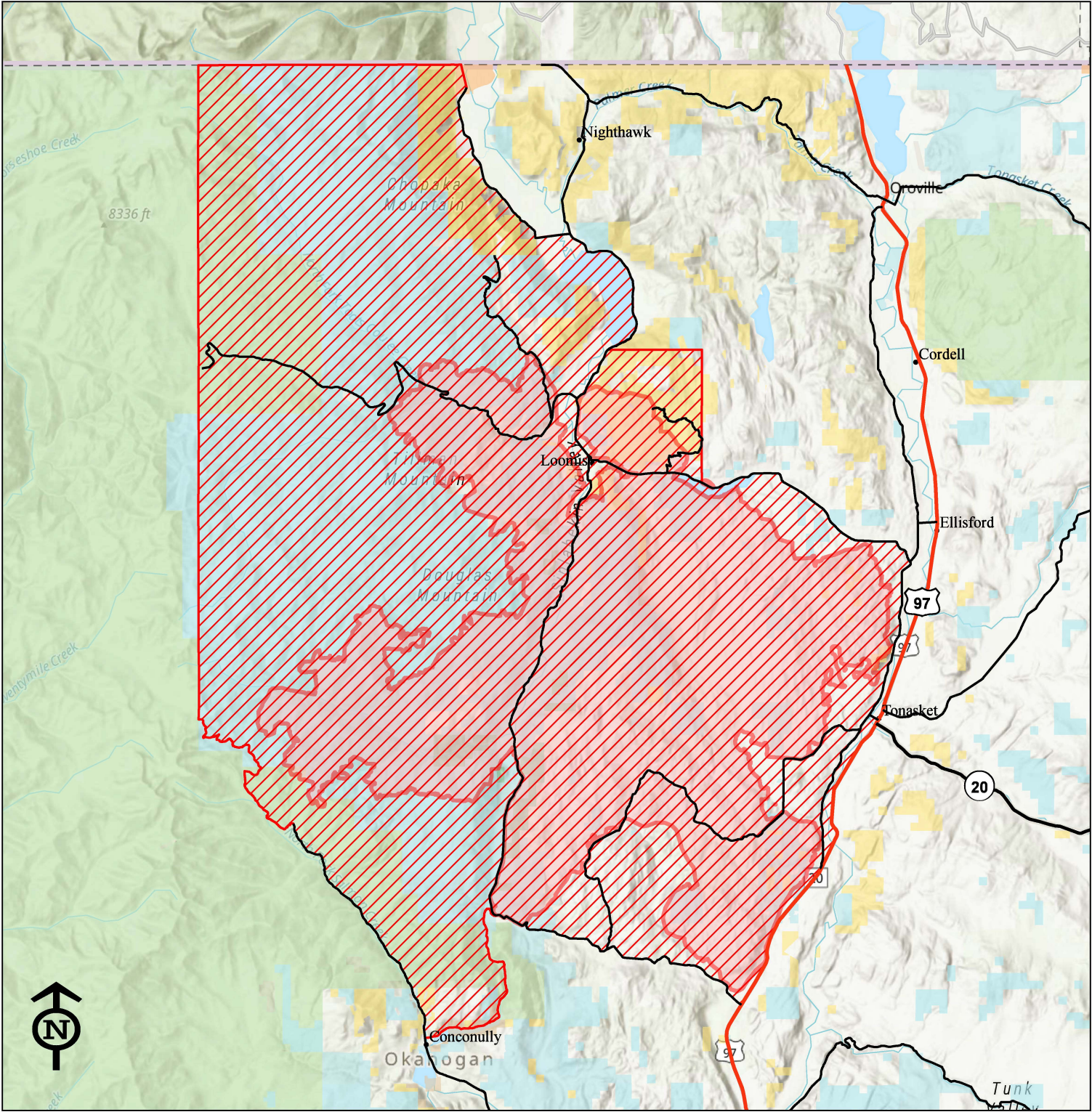
