



This 17 mile loop through Valley of the Gods has sharp turns and crosses several washes. Driving time is approximately one to two hours.

Valley of the Gods Road is graded gravel and clay. It is suitable for passenger cars when road conditions are dry. Local inquiry should be made during and after periods of inclement weather.

Dispersed camping is only permitted in previously impacted sites away from ponds and corrals.

No off road travel. Stay off roads for administrative use.

No campfires.
