

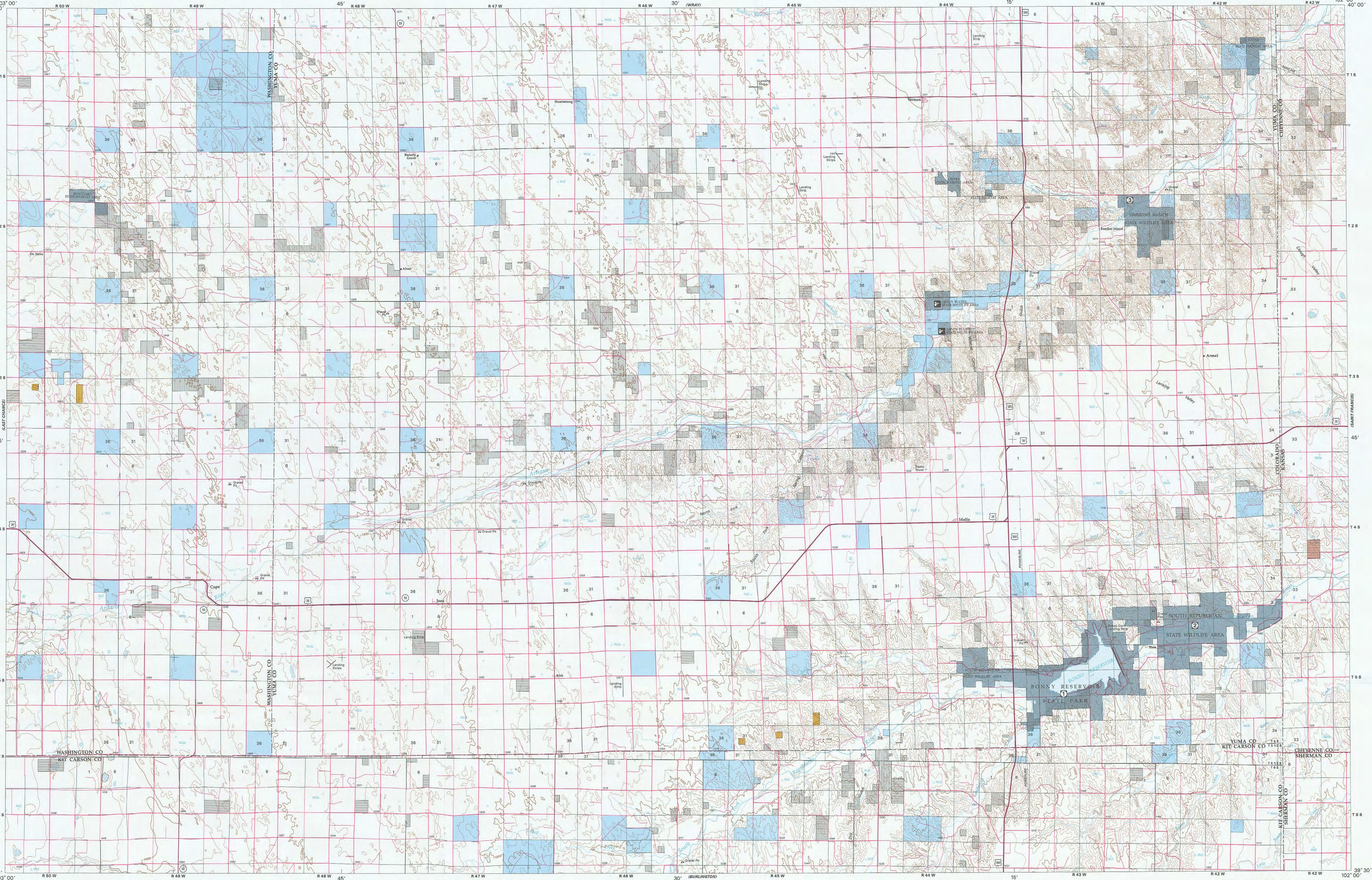

Table of topographic map symbols including primary highways, secondary highways, light duty roads, streets, trails, railroads, bridges, tunnels, built-up areas, airports, national boundaries, county boundaries, land grant boundaries, U.S. public lands survey, range, township, section, power transmission lines, pipelines, dams, canyons, water wells, windmills, mine shafts, campsgrounds, picnic areas, US location monuments, built-up areas, locality, elevation, and various other symbols.

NOTE TO MAP USERS

RECREATIONAL SYMBOL LEGEND and RECREATION SITES, TRAILS AND AREAS LEGEND. Includes symbols for campgrounds, boat ramps, motorboating, swimming, restrooms, and various recreation sites.

LAND STATUS LEGEND and MINERALS OWNED BY THE FEDERAL GOVERNMENT. Lists various land ownership types such as National Forest, National Wildlife Refuge, and State Land, along with mineral ownership categories like oil, gas, and coal.

SPECIAL SYMBOL LEGEND. Lists symbols for routes/trail markers, Bureau of Land Management, Forest Service, and roads with public access.

TOWNSHIP DIAGRAM and INDEX TO 1:24,000-SCALE MAPS. Includes a grid diagram for townships and an index table listing map sheets and their coordinates.
