- Creative Community Project Proposal: Length not to exceed 1 page (PDF format).
- Arts Festival Public Event Proposal: Length not to exceed 1 page (PDF format).
- Student Event Proposal: Length not to exceed 1 page (PDF format).
- Application Questions Responses: Length not to exceed 3 pages total (PDF format).
