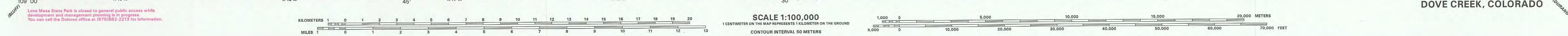
PUBLIC ACCESS: Roads crossing public lands may be needed by them. Public lands intended for grazing or other uses may be posted. Permission of the Bureau of Land Management is required to cross private land, unless access is provided by a Federal, State, or County road, or a BLM road with legal access.

RECREATIONAL SYMBOL LEGEND and RECREATION SITES, TRAILS AND AREAS LEGEND. Lists symbols for campgrounds, picnic areas, hiking trails, and various recreation sites.

LAND STATUS LEGEND. Lists various land ownership types such as National Forest, National Wildlife Refuge, State Land, and Private Land.

SPECIAL SYMBOL LEGEND and TOWNSHIP DIAGRAM. Lists symbols for Bureau of Land Management, National Park, and County boundaries, along with a township diagram grid.

INDEX TO 1:24,000-SCALE MAPS. A grid index for finding specific locations on larger scale maps.
