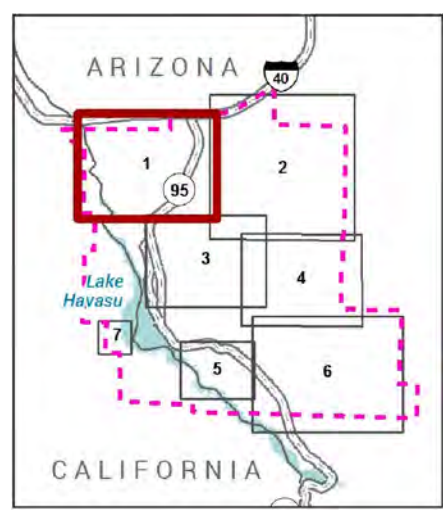
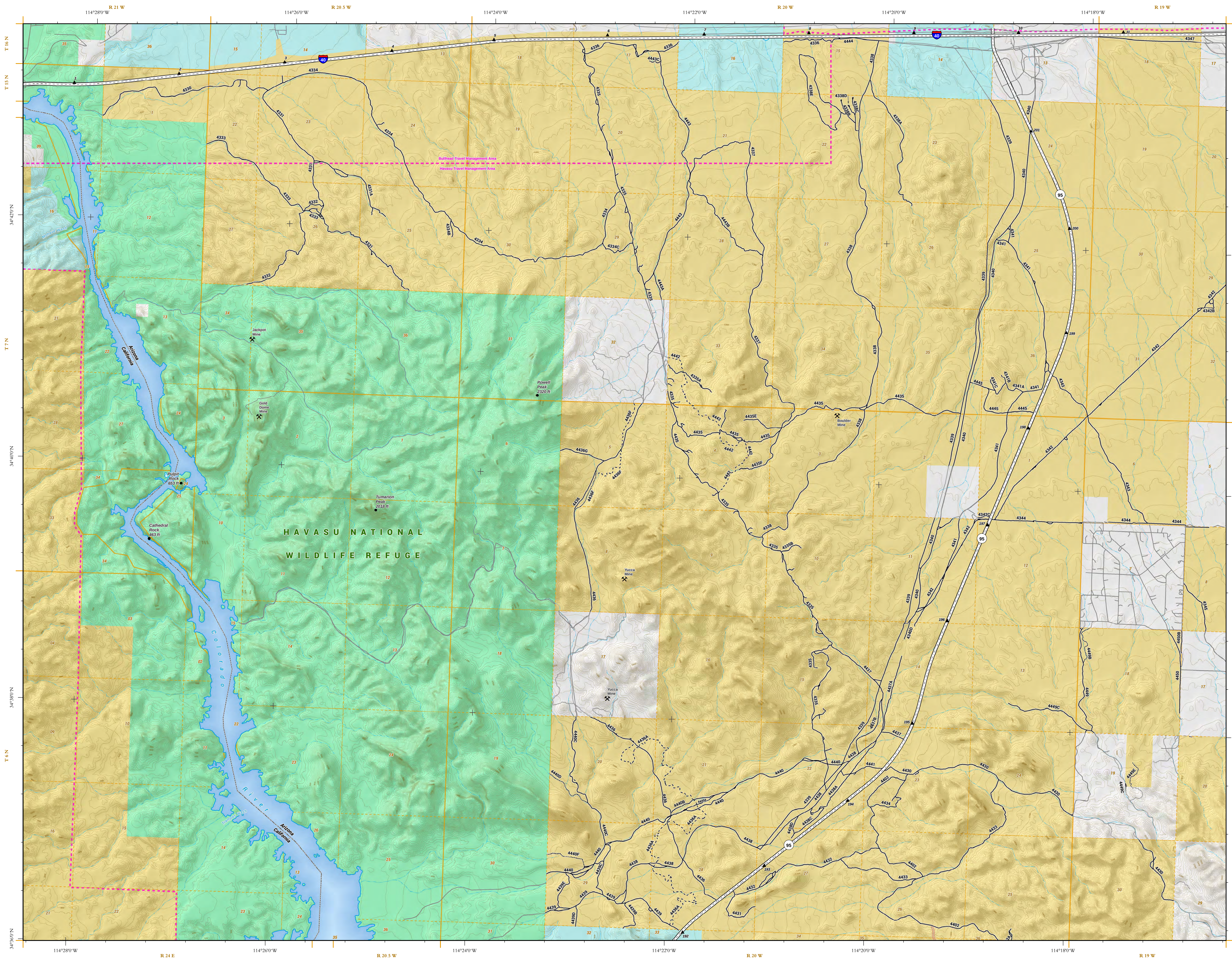




Lake Havasu

Technical Vehicle Site: Site primarily utilized for 4-wheel drive rock crawling.
