

## **KIRKLAND MINING COMPANY MODIFICATION OF NOTICE**

Kirkland Mining Company (KMC) wishes to make the following modifications to its Notice for exploration activities on its Capital lode claims submitted 8/11/15.

- The number of drill holes would be increased from seven to ten and two holes would be relocated to provide better coverage of the claims.
- The location of the drill holes would be as shown on the attachment titled *Claim Lines and Proposed Drill Holes*, prepared by geologist Karl Sandwell-Weiss. Drill hole coordinates are given on the attached table. An eleventh hole, KMC-ALT, is also shown. This hole would only be drilled if it is decided that one of the other holes is not needed. The total number of holes would remain at ten.
- All holes are now planned to be 100 feet or less in depth. Hole depth is expected to average 60 feet.
- Disturbance would now occur on Capital 4 lode claim (AMC 428991) in addition to Capital 2, 3, 6, 7 and 8 included in the original Notice.
- KMC's drilling contractor would use a track-mounted sonic drill that would not require use of a pipe truck as was anticipated in the original Notice. Drill pads and access routes were selected to accommodate the track drill and water truck without roadwork or site levelling. Therefore, no additional access road preparation would be required.
- The reclamation cost estimate has been updated to include three additional drill holes and 2500 square foot pads although disturbance on these pads is expected to be minimal.
- The total disturbed area would increase from 2.1 to 2.2 acres. The reclamation bond would increase from \$18,294 to \$19,568, an increase of \$1,274. The modified Bond Calculation Spreadsheet is attached.

Other provisions of the original Notice remain unchanged.
