To address number 2 requested modification (BLM letter 6/19/17) of the MRPO,

The following text to be added to the end of paragraph 5 in section 2.3.5. Transportation Plan:

On June 13, 2017, KMC met with the Director's Steve Mauk of Yavapai County Development Services, Bryon Jaspers of the Public Works Department, and Special Project Manager Joe Huot, of the Permit / Inspection Division, Public Works Department. The purpose of the meeting was to determine any necessary actions and permits to ensure traffic and public safety. The Public Works Department of Yavapai County asked that KMC consult with a traffic engineering firm to examine and confirm the integrity of the road surface. To meet the county request, KMC will consult with a licensed traffic engineer regarding the increased truck traffic based on the KMC Mine and Reclamation Plan of Operation.

This information will help determine the effects of the truck traffic and weight at the ingress point to the mine site; and what modification of roads or signage if any is needed to ensure traffic and public safety. Yavapai County has placed traffic count strips along county access roads to gather current traffic use information to supplement the engineering data. KMC will continue to closely coordinate with the Yavapai County Public Works Department.
