Hi Shelby,

Yes, 1:30 pm on April 18th works fine for us for submittal of the MPO. For agenda items per your earlier email, we would expect a fairly short meeting but would like to submit the MPO, the cultural and biological resource reports, other baseline information, and GIS data followed by any questions the BLM may have at that point. We would then like to discuss the MPO review process and timeline and the timeline for NEPA review after the MPO is accepted as ripe for NEPA.

Brian B. sent a message a while ago suggesting that Mondays might not be a good time for the site visit and that part of the process was to meet after the MPO is accepted for a presentation with a subsequent site visit. Kirkland certainly doesn't want to duplicate efforts nor repeat site visits, but would like to make sure the specialists have a chance to see the site as soon as possible so they can commence any work they need to do. So, if April 24 is not realistic and duplicative, please let me know so we can find another date to get schedules worked out.

We can play the field visit by ear for now, I'm not sure how long it will take for me to review the Plan of Operations at this point. The meeting is scheduled for main conference room on the "B" side (the main conference room and the fire ready room are already booked for that time frame). In that side of the room there is a screen that can be attached to a laptop with a HDMI (3?) cable. I haven't been able to locate an HDMI cable here yet.
