FIRE RESTRICTIONS

Stage 1 Fire Restrictions

Pursuant to Title 43 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 9212.2(a), **effective May 25, 2018**, and continuing until further notice due to fire danger, the Mother Lode Field Office will be going into **Stage 1 Fire Restrictions**.

Each of the following is **prohibited** on all BLM public lands under the jurisdiction of the Mother Lode Field Office:

- 1) **CAMPFIRES**: Building, maintaining, attending, or using an open fire, or campfires and BBQ grills, unless within a campfire ring in a designated developed recreation site.

Lanterns or portable stoves using gas, jellied petroleum or pressurized liquid fuel are allowed.

- 2) Welding or operating acetylene or other torch with open flame.
- 3) Operating an internal combustion engine off road, except on maintained roads.
- 4) No recreational target shooting. Hunting is exempt.
- 5) No fireworks of any kind.
- 6) Using or cause to be used any type of explosives except, by special permit.

Pursuant to Title 43 CFR 9212.2(b)(3) each of the following persons are exempt from this order:

- 1) Any Federal, state, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or firefighting force in performance of an official duty.
- 2) Persons with a permit or contract specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited acts.

These prohibitions are in addition to the General Fire Restrictions contained in 43 CFR 9212.1 Issued in El Dorado Hills, California this 25th day of May, 2018
