ROUTES

- HIGHWAY
- ROAD: Roads are open to all motorized and non-motorized use unless specified otherwise. Portions of all roads are rocky, unpaved and may require a high-clearance vehicle.
- PRIMITIVE ROAD: A route managed for use by four-wheel drive or high-clearance vehicles. Primitive roads are not normally paved and may require a high-clearance vehicle.
- MOTORCYCLE TRAIL (single track)
- ATV TRAIL (vehicles 50" wide or less)
- NON-MOTORIZED TRAIL
- FOREST SERVICE ROAD OR TRAIL (refer to USFS Motor Vehicle Use Maps from each Ranger District)

Campground Stay Limits

Camping is limited to a maximum of 14 consecutive days in a period of 30 days on all public lands in Idaho. After 14 days, campers must move to another campsite at least 25 miles away. 43 CFR 8365.1-2 (a)

Personal property may not be left unattended for more than 24 consecutive hours in a day use area, and 72 hours in other areas. The county sheriff will be notified to confiscate all abandoned property after 36 hours. 43 CFR 8365.2-3 (k)
