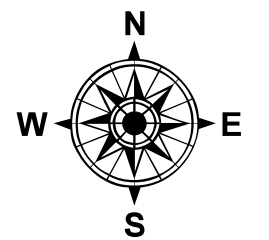
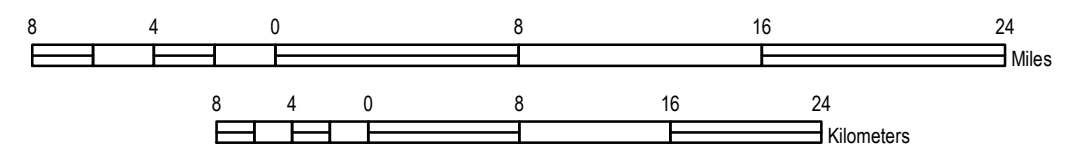

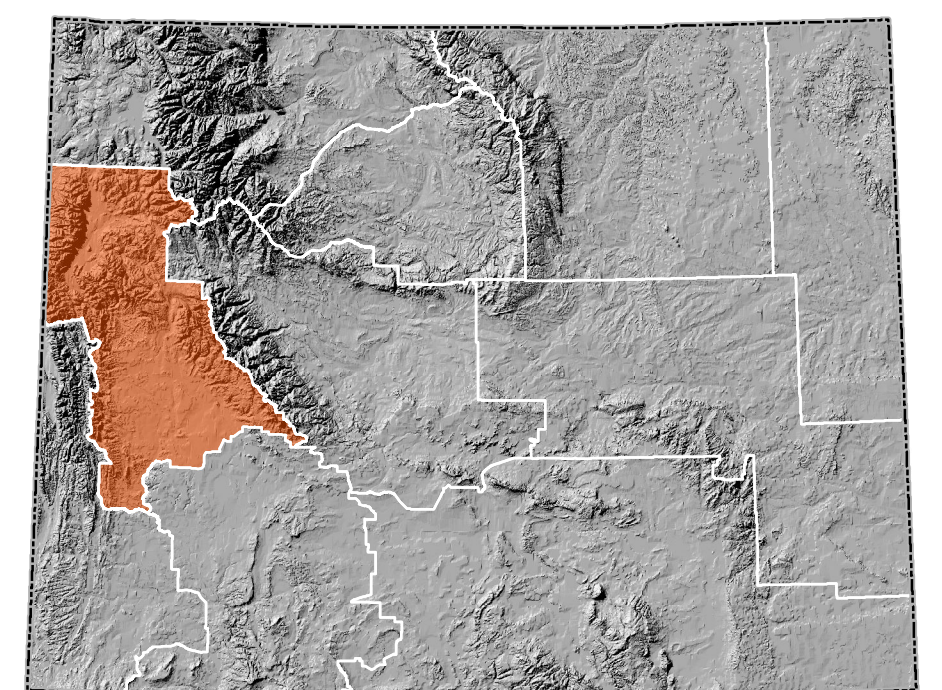
Universal Transverse Mercator Projection - Zone 12N
