Order Number CAC05000-18-02 Fire Prevention Orders

Fire Use Restrictions

In compliance with **Title 43 Code of Federal Regulations, Section 9212.2**, the following acts are **prohibited** on public lands within the Bureau of Land Management Ukiah Field Office jurisdiction beginning at 12:01 a.m. on August 4, 2018, and continuing until further notice:

1. Campfires, charcoal barbecues or stoves and open fires, including in a designated developed recreation site (see exhibit A), or a specifically posted campsite or area. Portable stoves using gas, jelled petroleum or pressurized liquid fuel are exempt from this restriction with a valid California campfire permit.
2. To use as firewood, or possess, any firewood materials containing nails, screws, other metal hardware, or treated wood, including, but not limited to, wood pallets and/or construction debris.
3. Smoking, except within an enclosed vehicle or building, at a designated developed recreation site or other designated areas.
4. To operate or cause to be operated any OHV, portable tool such as chainsaw or lawnmower or other device powered by an internal combustion engine off established roads or trails on public lands.
5. All recreational target shooting. Use of firearms in the legal pursuit of wild game is still allowed.
6. To possess or discharge fireworks, including "safe and sane" fireworks.

Pursuant to **43 CFR 9212.2 (3)**, the following persons are exempt from this order:

1. Persons with a permit specifically authorizing the otherwise prohibited act.
2. Any Federal, State, or local officer, or member of an organized rescue or fire fighting force in the performance of an official duty.

The area, roads and trails affected by this order are all BLM-managed public lands within the boundaries of the Ukiah Field Office.

(Title 43, C.F.R. 9212.1; 9214.4)

§ 9212.1 Prohibited acts.

Unless permitted in writing by the authorized officer, it is prohibited on the public lands to:

- (h) Perform any act restricted by a fire prevention order.

§ 9212.4 Penalties.

Any person who knowingly and willfully violates the regulations at § 9212.1 of this title shall, upon conviction, be subject to a fine of not more than \$1,000 or to imprisonment of not more than 12 months, or both.
