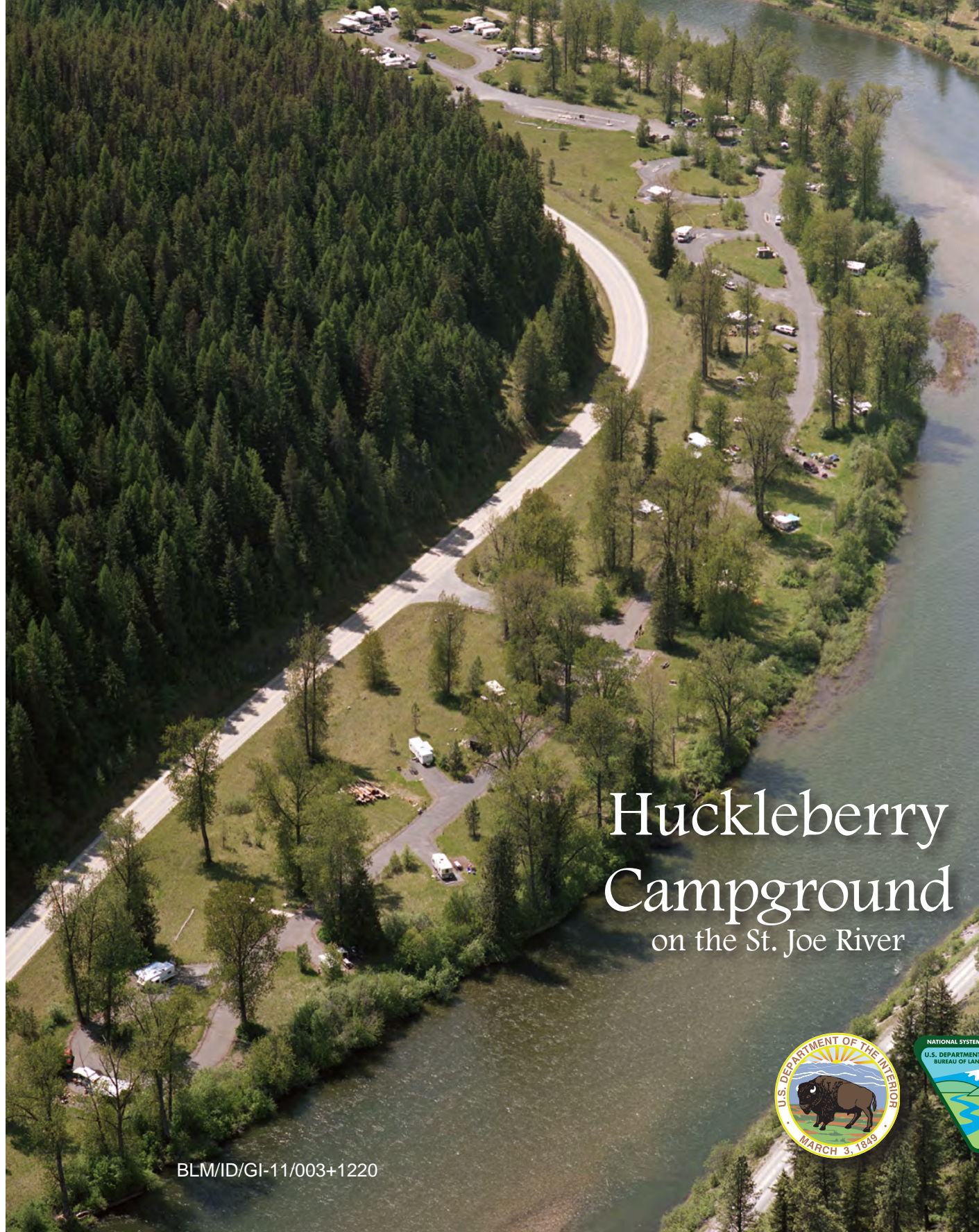


## Campground Rules

- ▶ Garbage goes in trash cans only and not in the fire rings! Aluminum cans and all forms of plastic should be recycled.
- ▶ ORV drivers (off-road vehicle) within the campground must have a valid driver's license.
- ▶ All ORV use is restricted to the site roadway and the camp spurs.
- ▶ Driving or parking any motorized vehicle on the grass or tent pads is prohibited.
- ▶ Parking on the gravel beside the camp spurs and along the site roadway cannot impede traffic.
- ▶ Pay your camp fee within ½ hour of selecting a campsite. Post the receipt on the clip provided on the site number post. Be sure to fill out the fee permit in full.
- ▶ Keep your pets on a leash! Leashes must be 6 feet or less in length in developed campgrounds. Pets must be in the control of the owner at all times.
- ▶ Clean up after your pets. Pet waste bags supplied at stations near east entrance and near the dump station.
- ▶ Quiet time is from 10:00 pm to 6:00 am.
- ▶ The maximum length of stay is 14 nights.

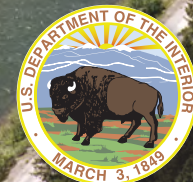

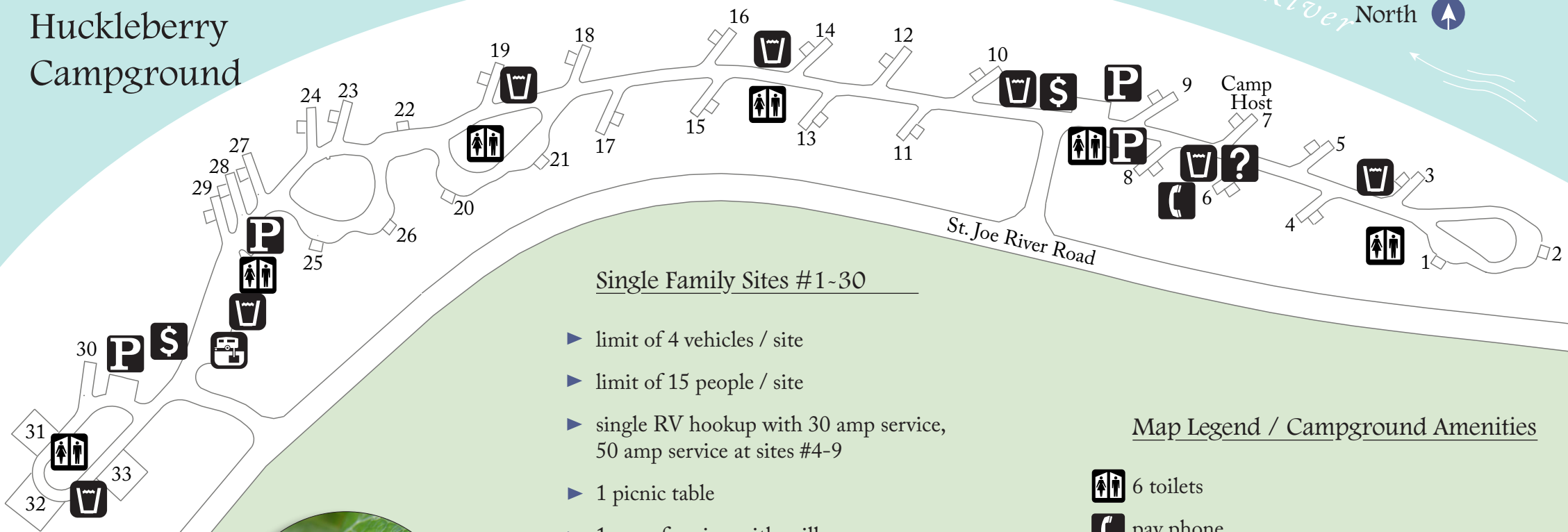


# Huckleberry Campground

## Single Family Sites #1-30

- ▶ limit of 4 vehicles / site
- ▶ limit of 15 people / site
- ▶ single RV hookup with 30 amp service, 50 amp service at sites #4-9
- ▶ 1 picnic table
- ▶ 1 campfire ring with grill
- ▶ 1 tent pad (tents are also allowed off pad)

## Camping Fee Requirements

- ▶ \$18.00 per site per night with electricity and water hookup
- ▶ \$14.00 per night without electricity
- ▶ +\$5.00 per night extra vehicle not in tow
- ▶ +\$4.00 per night extra electric hookup
- ▶ +\$5.00 dump station maintenance fee
- ▶ Holders of the Golden Age Pass and the America the Beautiful-The National Parks and Federal Recreational Lands Senior and Access Pass pay half of the standard fee.

## Map Legend / Campground Amenities

- 6 toilets
- pay phone
- information kiosk
- overflow parking lots
- RV dump-station (Memorial Day - October)
- 7 fresh water stations
- fee collection stations at each entrance (fees collected at this site are used at this site)
- recycling program utilized
  - ▶ horseshoe pits near each entrance
  - ▶ 7 convenient pull through sites
  - ▶ paved roadway and single family site parking
  - ▶ firewood available
  - ▶ trees and shrubs providing separation between individual sites and highway



## Large Group Sites #31-33

- ▶ limit of 6 vehicles / site
- ▶ limit of 25 people / site
- ▶ 3 sets of RV hookups with 30 amp service / site
- ▶ 2 picnic tables / site
- ▶ 2 campfire rings with grills / site
