### **KNOW BEFORE YOU GO**

- SHELTER RESERVATIONS can be made by contacting the Springfield BLM Office.
- **PERMITS** are required spring through fall; one-day permit and seasonal permits are available.
- SITE HOURS vary per season.
- **DOGS** are permitted on leash; dog waste bags are provided on site.

#### **DIRECTIONS**

Take exit 194A from I- 5 onto Highway 126. Travel 4 miles east to the 42nd Street exit. Turn left and proceed to Marcola Road. Turn right and continue northeast about 10 miles towards the town of Marcola. Proceed through the town towards Shotgun Creek Road (look for signage). Turn left at Shotgun Creek Road and travel northwest about 2 miles. Site entrance is on the right.
