Cox Individual (0217) S&G review of riparian conditions

On initial S&G assessment in 2005 the riparian conditions on the head of the hot spring were listed as non functional due to livestock impacts. Since that time a fence was constructed to keep livestock off the spring head.

Conditions on the spring were assessed on November 16, 2007. The vegetation on the spring head has improved substantially with many of the hummocky areas filling in and stabilizing. While riparian conditions on the spring head (BLM) are still not fully functional livestock management is no longer the cause. With implementation of the fence the allotment meets the requirements of S&G assessment.
