WATMOUGH BAY



WELCOME TO WATMOUGH BAY!

The protected Watmough Bay provides excellent recreational opportunities for visitors who come by boat or foot to hike, relax, picnic, and enjoy the stunning scenery. A trail from the trailhead parking area to the beach allows easy access for all visitors. Watmough Bay is cooperatively managed with the San Juan County Land Bank and San Juan Preservation Trust who share portions of the area and adjacent properties.



KNOW BEFORE YOU GO

- **ACCESSIBILITY** Watmough Bay is available for day-use only. Overnight camping is not allowed.
- **PARKING** is limited.
- **CROWDS** The site can be somewhat crowded during the peak use of the summer; visitors can enjoy more solitude during the shoulder seasons.
- TREAD LIGHTLY Please stay on designated trails to protect sensitive wildlife habitat.
- **PETS** are ALLOWED but must be LEASHED (max. 6 feet). Please dispose all pet waste in trash receptacles.

DIRECTIONS

Drive south from Lopez Village on Fisherman Bay Road. Keep left onto Mud Bay Road, turn right at Aleck Bay Road, then left on Watmough Bay Road. Follow this road approximately 1.5 miles, then turn left at the bottom of a small hill at the Watmough Bay sign. Please park in the trailhead parking area.
